Important information about Kill Devil Hills located in the Outer Banks of North Carolina. There is no public transportation in the Outer Banks, but the towns/cities are small enough for you to walk through. If you want to visit other cities such as Corolla, Duck, Avon, etc., you would need to know someone with a car or be comfortable riding your bike to those places. Another option is to call for a taxi to come from Elizabeth City, however, this can get expensive.

Housing: The employer will not provide any housing assistance. CHI will suggest a motel for you to start off in, however, you will need to be prepared to find your own housing and will need to make sure that it is close enough to your work so that you are able to arrive to work on time, as scheduled.

If so, details for clothing:	You must bring with you: black/non-skid/close-toed shoes, black or tan pants or shorts (NO SHORT SHORTS; if you choose to wear shorts they must be fingertip length or longer). Employer will provide you with a shirt and hat. Grooming: clean cut/conservative appearance, no facial hair, no bold hair or nail colors, facial piercings limited to 1 in each ear only, while working stud earrings only. No visible tatoos. Long hair will have to be pulled up and back off of shoulders and away from the face.
Additional information:	The possibility to change positions and for overtime depends on the needs of the employer at that time in addition to your work performance and attendance. You should plan to have work nights as well as weekends. There is no promise of a set schedule or working a set shift. You should expect to work holidays as well.

Specific instructions:	After arriving, make your way to Kill Devil Hills either to the CHI suggested start off housing or the housing of your choice. Get a good night's sleep \$ check in Monday-Thursday, between 9am - 12 noon only. You will not be allowed to check in on any other day or during any other time. Make sure to arrive on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday only. If not, you will be delayed in starting work.

- 6 Transportation Choices:
 If flying into Norfolk Airport:
- 1) Carey VIP transportation (approx \$180 can handle large groups and/or large amounts of luggage, rates vary by number of people). No reservations required. After you get your luggage at the airport just go out door number 3 in the baggage claim area and you will see a kiosk with a Carey representative there.
 - 2) You could take a taxi (approx \$160 normally can handle up to 3 people with limited space for luggage). After getting your luggage, go outside door number 4 by luggage claim and go to the first taxi in line.
 - 3) With 1 week notice, email chiteresa@chinet.org and she can often arrange for a private pick up and someone will stand by luggage claim with a sign with your name on it. (\$120 flat rate for transportation of up to 3 people)

- If you are arriving into any other airport, you should travel by Greyhound Bus:
- 4) If you want to use a taxi, take the bus to Norfolk, Virginia and then take a taxi the rest of the way. You could take the bus to Elizabeth City, N.C. however, past students have claimed that many of the taxi drivers in Elizabeth City overcharge them, so the choice is yours.
 - 5) If you want to use the private transportation that is offered for the flat rate of \$120 for up to 3 people and you are arriving into another Airport other than Norfolk, you would want to take Greyhound Bus to Hampton, Virginia and you will be picked up from there. Please remember this choice requires you email and confirm your arrival with 1 week notice.
 - 6) Make your own arrangements.
