Job description and required skills: THIS IS A PART TIME POSITION. STUDENTS WILL ONLY WORK AT STADIUM WHEN METS ARE AT HOME. Sweep and mop floors; wash worktables, walls, refrigerators, and meat blocks. Segregate and remove trash and garbage and place it in designated containers; Steam-clean or hose out garbage cans; sort bottles and break disposable ones in bottle-crushing machine; wash pots, pans, and trays by hand. Scrape food from dirty dishes and wash them by hand or place them in racks or on conveyor to dishwashing machine. Polish silver, using burnishing-machine tumbler, chemical dip, buffing wheel, and hand cloth. Transfer supplies and equipment between storage and work areas by hand or by use of hand truck. Set up banquet tables. Put dishes and utensils away in areas designated by Chef/Manager. Properly clean and sanitize equipment and surfaces in the kitchen.
