Beach Mart owns more than 10 retail souvenir stores and a gym along the Outer Banks of North Carolina. If you enjoy the beach, sand, ocean, fresh air and outdoors, this is the place you want to be.

The Outer Banks is primarily a summer family oriented beach resort area and there is no public transportation. But even during the winter months if you enjoy reading, writing, painting/drawing and the outdoors, it is still a great place to come to. You will be assigned to work at one of the many stores along the 125 miles of shoreline upon arrival. If you are traveling with a friend or two, make sure to let the employer know as soon as possible, so that they can do their best to house you together. Groups of friends (3 or more) may not be the best for this job as they will surely be separated on some level.

You do not have to worry about housing with this employer. Housing is mandatory and provided by the employer at a cost of 100.00 per person per week with a 100.00 per person refundable deposit. Each apartment/house is modestly furnished, however you must bring your own sheets, towels and pillows. The beds provided are single size and are not on frames so the mattress and box spring set on the floor.

Job title: Cashier / Stocker - Very Late

Job description and required skills: Once a student is assigned a location it is rare that they are moved. You may be trained in and required to do one or all of the following: cashiering, stocking, pricing, folding merchandise and cleaning both inside and outside the stores, including bathrooms. All guys are required to be able to lift up to 50 pounds regularly; you will most likely have additional duties transporting stock from the warehouse to the various stores. Also, guys may work a few days a week in the warehouse.

If so, details for clothing:	Keep piercings at a minimum male & female. No short skirts/shorts, no high heels. No tops that show your stomach, example NO TUBE TOPS. Dress in casual comfortable, conservative clothing. Well groomed/no-natural looking hair colors, no facial piercings (except for ears).
Additional information:	You can only check in Mon-Fri from 9am-5pm (do not arrive outside of these hours if you do you will have to get a hotel room and they are \$100+ a night.) Upon arrival go to the Beach Mart office to do paperwork, be assigned to your store and housing. If you are traveling with friends, please notify the employer prior to arriving stating who you are traveling with. The employer will do their best to keep you together or at least place you working/living at locations that are close enough for you to visit each other easily. The more notice they have the better your chances, but there still is no guarantee. You will be required to live in the housing that you are assigned; you may not change. You need to bring your own sheets (twin size), towels and pillows. All stores are within a 20-mile radius.

Students are asked to read & sign a lease for the house or apartment where they will be living. This is for the protection of the student & employer. The type of housing may be a house, condo or apartment depending on location.
