Floor assistants help guests find items, restock, organize, clean & help where necessary. All positions (except cooks & dishwashers) have a lot of contact with our guests. Students will receive a cleaning checklist prior to leaving so they know what is expected in order to receive a full refund. Rent will be \$75 per week, per student. All employees will have rent directly withdrawn from their paychecks biweekly (\$150) * There will be periodic room inspections by our liaison to ensure rooms are being maintained. A schedule will be made and prior notice will be given to students so they are fully aware of when our liaison will be coming to inspect their room. A common area cleaning schedule will be developed and followed by all cast members to help ensure a clean and healthy cooking/living space for all.
